


Ben's story

My mum left my dad when I was 11 and I began getting bullied at school. I tried cannabis at the age of 13 and started stealing off my family to fund it. The worse thing was the paranoia. I tried to give up drugs, but they were around me all the time. I developed drug induced psychosis. I was sectioned (under the Mental Health Act) and ended up in a secure hospital twice. I went to prison for breaking and entering. I tried to stay clean when I got out but fell back in with the wrong crowd. I ended up in a homeless hostel and started to replace speed with alcohol - I eventually ended up back in hospital.

I was fed up with my life. I was wasting it going round in circles so I started to build relationships with my family. I then moved to Langley. This was my first big break. I had freedom as well as support around me. I was clean. The staff were really supportive. They helped me get my head straight and get the right meds. They also got me back into learning – something I hadn't done for a long time. I have just completed a maths course and am now doing a GCSE. My hope for the future is to get a job and live in the community.

Without Langley I wouldn't have had a chance.
