ABOUT BOX TREE COTTAGE

Box Tree Cottage Independent Approved Premises is a service run in partnership with HMPPS. We offer meaningful activities that are tailored to meet individual needs in order to minimise the risk of reoffending. Langley has a track record of changing lives with a reconviction rate of just 3%.

- Space for 17 men
- Opens April 2022
- A national resource extending provision in West Yorkshire
- Delivered from a hostel that has operated in its location for over 40 years

Provision at Box Tree Cottage

- Responsive, individually tailored and purposeful support for all residents
- An inclusive approach designed to meet rehabilitation and resettlement needs.
- Support to build self-esteem and a positive self-identity.
- Where appropriate, support to reconnect with family, find employment and a permanent home.
- Trained staff contribute to ongoing assessment and management of all residents, including Multi-Agency Public Protection Arrangements (MAPPA) and Integrated Offender Management (IOM)




STRUCTURED ACTIVITIES

A range of mandatory and optional activities and support to help people under probation supervision overcome multiple, complex needs and reintegrate into the community.

Help with Addiction

Box Tree Cottage staff work closely with the local services to support those struggling with addiction. This support includes harm reduction and managing prescriptions. Our staff are trained to administer medication including controlled drugs, such as Methadone and Buprenorphine.



Structured Interventions

Staff and partners will deliver a range of structured interventions to address criminogenic needs identified both during assessment and by the people under probation supervision themselves. These will include:

- Life skills such as budgeting, healthy eating, nutrition, and cooking.
- Development of skills for employment.
- Engagement groups to support compliance, build motivation and personal goal setting.
- Health and wellbeing to include emotional management and coping mechanisms.
- Working with probation staff to support people under probation supervision with the development of skills to successfully manage their onward accommodation.

Our secure and structured environment enables the close monitoring and supervision of people's behaviour, as well as compliance with any additional requirements, which may include bail or licence conditions. The specialist monitoring and support at Box Tree Cottage will reduce the risk of reoffending and harm, promote rehabilitation and wherever possible, help people return to their home area and reintegrate into their local community.

Who can be referred?

- No offence automatically excludes a referral
- People under probation supervision on licence
- Those released on temporary licence (ROTL)
- Bailees

The Approved Premises will be a national resource with HM Prison and Probation Service (HMPPS) referring people under probation supervision following a thorough risk assessment.

All referrals are sent to the National Probation Service Central Referral Unit. The Approved Premises does not accept direct referrals.
